



## Central City Schools Cluster Walking Tour

The Central City Schools Cluster project was unusual from start to finish. School principals were impatient for action after years of worsening road safety issues.

By considering the whole study area as one precinct (the “Central Schools Cluster”), a series of consistent treatments was used to reinforce to all users entering the area (especially motorists) that they need to look out for other users (especially school pupils) and behave appropriately.

Council aimed to find low-cost trial treatments to address speeding, road crossings, and parking issues – with a view to making the most successful treatments permanent. The trial approach enabled Council to overcome concerns that “it won’t work” and refine the design of particular site improvements. Join this tour to learn about the innovative approach, materials used, successes and lessons learned. You will see speed thresholds, new crossings, parking management devices found only in Dunedin, and intersection treatments.
