## Baldwin Street puts the “RAD” into Gradient

This is the brief story of how a gap in Guinness World Record’s criteria for measuring road gradients allowed Ffordd Pen Llech to nab the title of World’s steepest street from Baldwin Street, how the error was discovered, and the efforts to have the world record reinstated.
